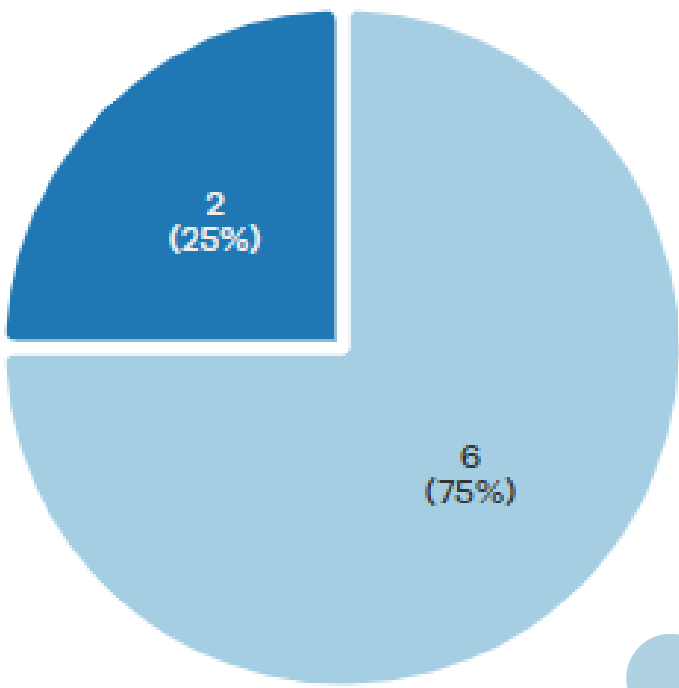

Working Group Overview

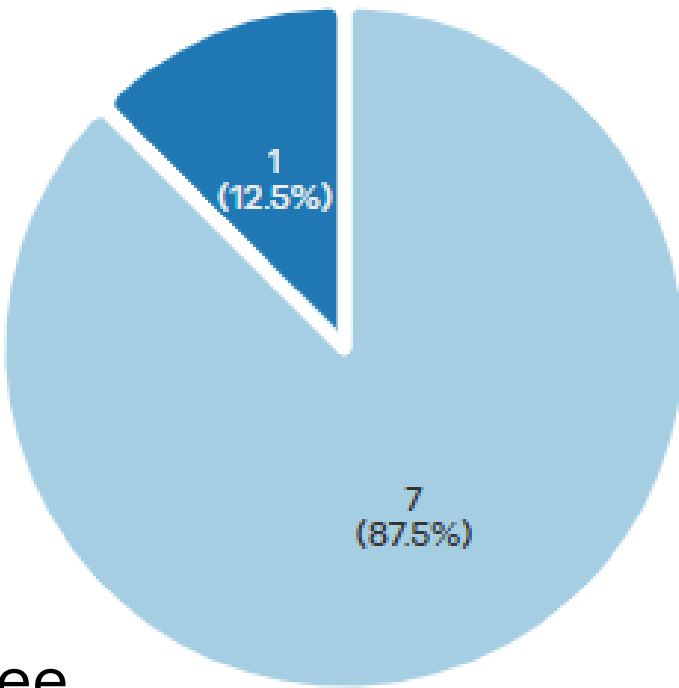

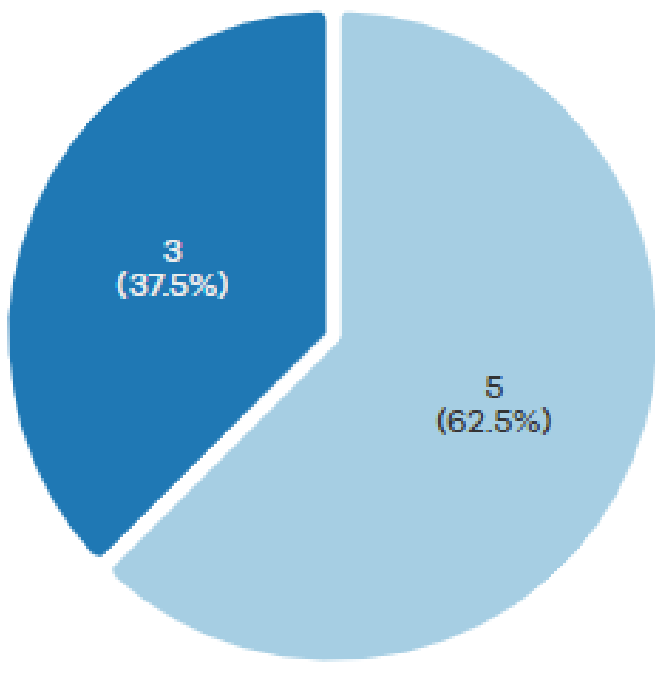

Sessions content was organized and easy to follow



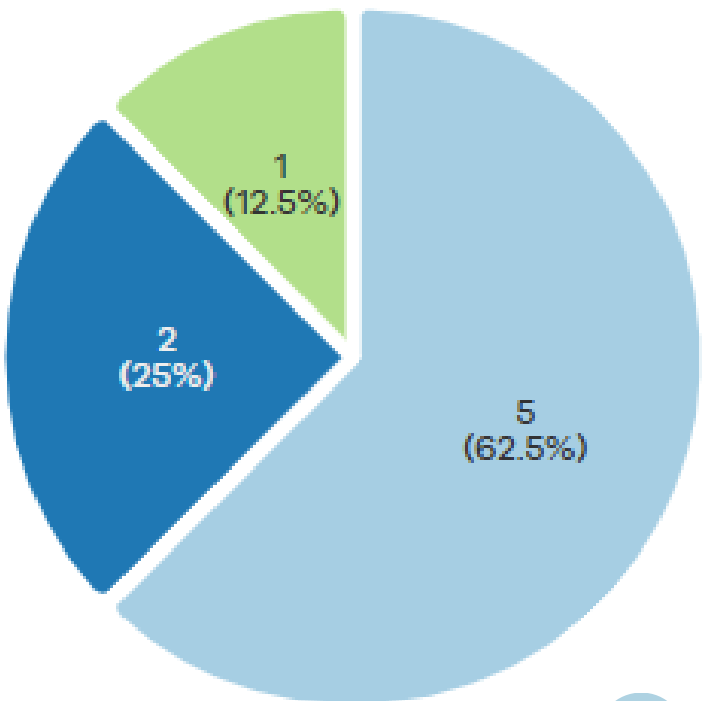

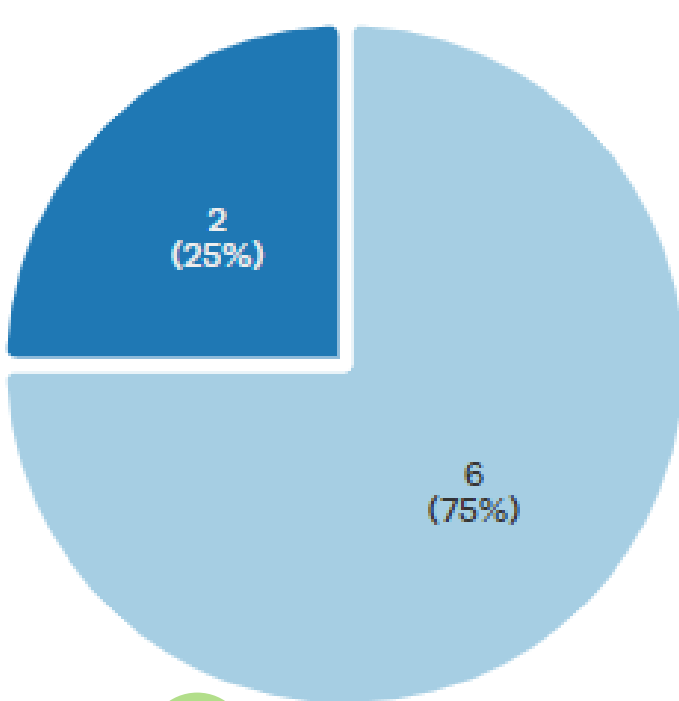

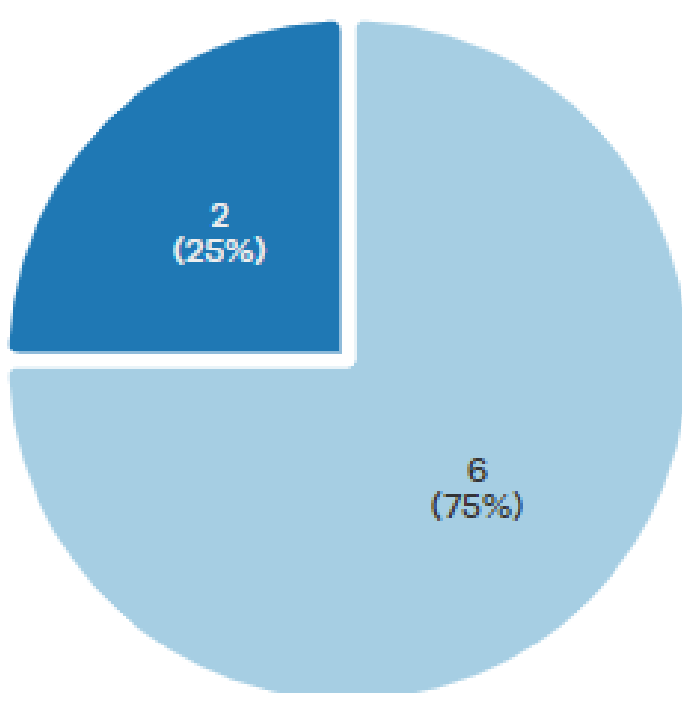
Time commitment has been manageable and appropriate

Appropriate balance of discussion and sharing

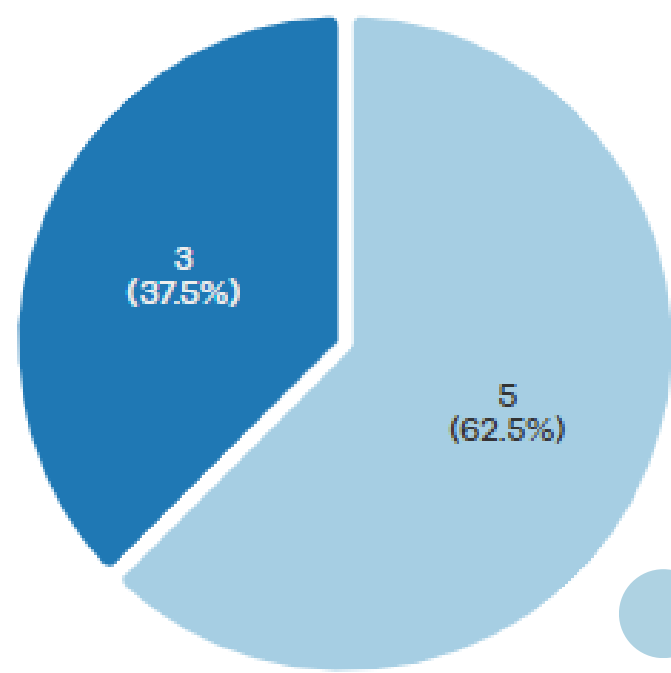

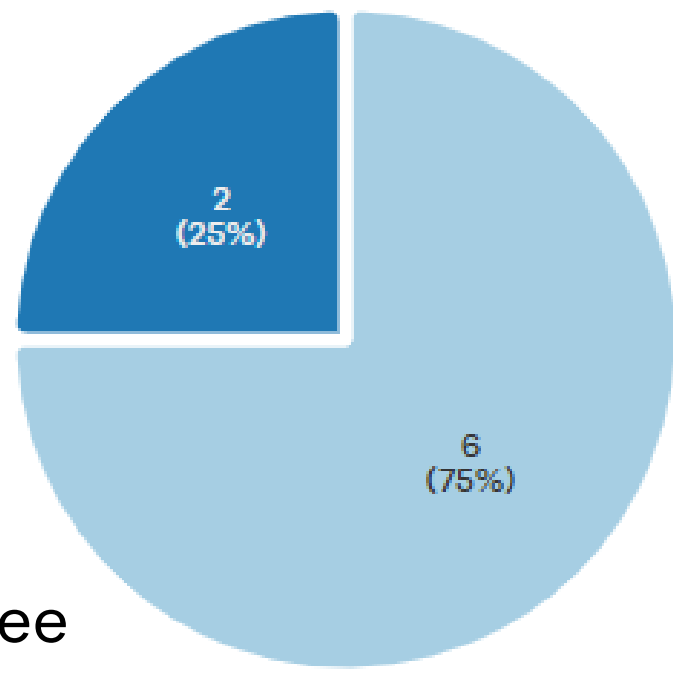
"Could a "live" poll taking (ie. Mentimeter) be of any value? I think the current tools have been quite effective so far!"

Interaction and Engagement

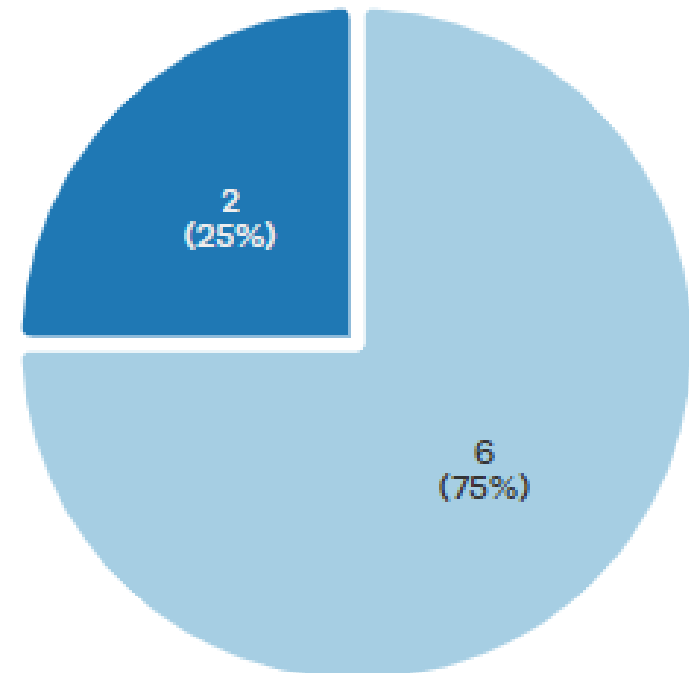
Session structure and facilitation encouraged active participation



Facilitation supported respectful, inclusive & productive dialogue



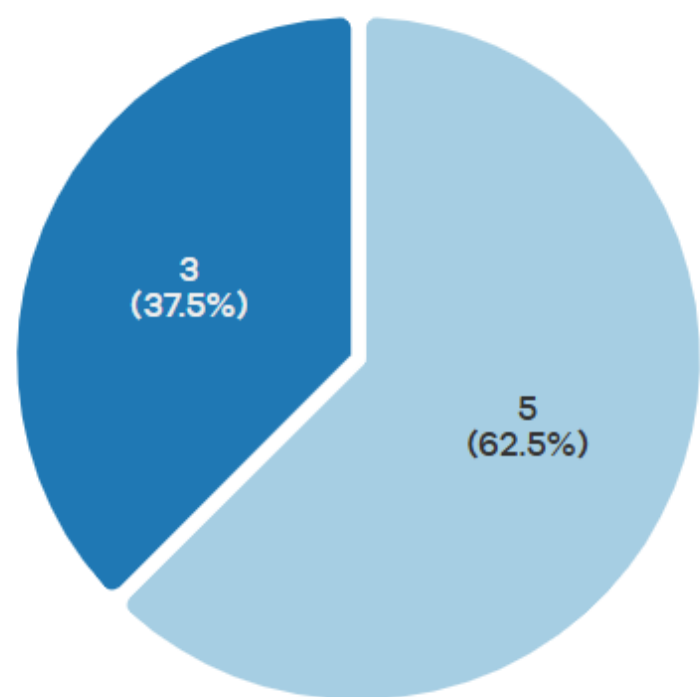
Participants valued hearing from one another and the mix of perspectives added value



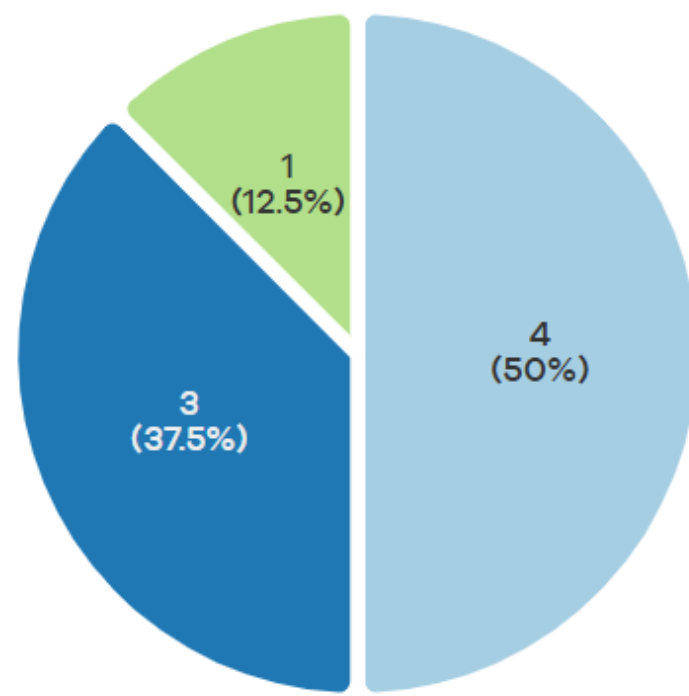

Outcomes and Impact

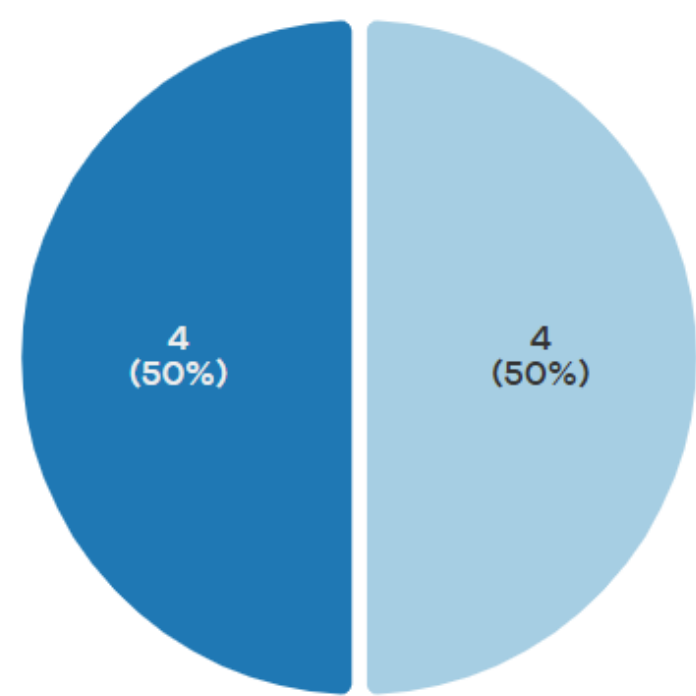
Participants feel motivated by the goals of the group and the plans to achieve them
