# Villa Cathay Care Home



Villa Cathay Care Home has been home to frail seniors who needed care but would otherwise face cultural and language barriers in English-speaking care homes for over four decades since 1973. Villa Cathay Care Home is one of the two only licensed non-profit facilities in the Lower Mainland that provides comprehensive culturally focused long-term care for Chinese seniors. The original Villa Cathay Care Home was built in the 1976. To meet the growing demand for culturally focused long-term care, Villa Cathay Care Home embarked on a \$72.9 Million Rejuvenation Project in 2016 to rebuild Villa Cathay at its current site with the goal to enhance its quality of care.

Villa Cathay Care Home Rejuvenation Project has been completed in November 2021. The care home is now one of the largest long-term care homes in the Lower Mainland and actively inviting physicians to join the amazing, dynamic team and welcome the 71 residents to come!

The new Villa Cathay design focuses on improving residents' quality of life and creating a sense of home, and enhances residents' comfort, sense of autonomy, ability, and dignity.



### Small Neighbourhood Design

The new Villa Cathay adopts the "small neighbourhood Design" so that each floor resembles and functions like a Each neighbourhood is equipped with nursing station, dining room, TV lounge, outdoor space and a spa room.





## All Single Ensuite Room for Residents

All resident rooms are individual single rooms with en-suite washroom and shower. Each room has floor-to-ceiling windows that draw in a lot of natural light. The room is equipped with hi-low full-electric bed, ceiling lift, nursing call system, and seniorfriendly furniture.
