# Vancouver Primary Care Network (PCN) Steering Committees

# Patient Partners: add your voice to help improve primary care in Vancouver!

BACKGROUND: Together with Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH), the Ministry of Health and the First Nations Health Authority, the Vancouver Divisions of Family Practice (VDoFP) is working to build Primary Care Networks in Vancouver. Over the past few years, we have gotten new allied health resources to ground, launched a program to bring Registered Nurses into primary care clinics in Vancouver, as well as supported contracts with family physicians and nurse practitioners to provide care. Since 2021, our work has been supported by a Patient Partner Advisory Group that has advised our PCN steering Committees, as well as numerous other PCN projects and initiatives.

**YOUR INVOLVEMENT:** We are now seeking to add additional Patient Partners (3-4) who live or receive their primary care (provided by a family physician or nurse practitioner) in Vancouver to our advisory committee. Patient Partners will continue to advise on PCN work, as well as potentially join one of the PCN Steering Committees. PCN Steering Committees will include Family Doctors, a Nurse Practitioner, a VCH Representative as well as additional membership as determined by the needs and scope of the PCNs and the committees' work.

- Live or receive your primary care in Vancouver

**TIME COMMITMENT:** Formal steering committee meetings will happen 3 times a year (April 10, July 24, Nov 13 – dates subject to change) with additional work happening in between (approx. 3 – 6 hours monthly). PCN Steering Committee membership term will be assessed after one year and likely move to 3 years.


