## **PCN Clinical Pharmacist Co-location**

## What is it?

A PCN Clinical Pharmacist can be co-located at your clinic on a regular schedule to fit your needs. This model of care facilitates:

- Referrals to be tasked to the PCN Pharmacist via the clinic's EMR prior to their visit
- In-clinic appointments, meetings, and/or educational sessions for patients and providers
- Case conferencing that can be done in-clinic and directly with the PCN Clinical Pharmacist
- PCN Clinical Pharmacists to provide consult notes including their assessment and recommendations directly in your clinic's EMR

## What are the benefits?

The PCN Clinical Pharmacist will bring their expertise to support medication management directly to your clinic's context. A Clinic Co-location with EMR Access:

## What is required?

- Fill out an Expression of Interest Form. **Note:** If EMR access costs or spacing is an issue, your Community Network Manager can support
- Determine a regular schedule and clinic referral workflow with the PCN Clinical Pharmacist. This will be done together with your Community Network Manager, Lower Mainland Pharmacy Services, and the PCN Clinical Pharmacist.
- Provide the PCN Clinical Pharmacist access to your clinic EMR, a dedicated workspace, and Wi-Fi
- Sign a Memorandum of Understanding Agreement with Vancouver Coastal Health
