What is a PCN Clinical Pharmacist?

Primary Care Network (PCN) Clinical Pharmacists are part of the Interprofessional Teams that provide Comprehensive Medication Management services to patients.

PCN Clinical Pharmacists work collaboratively with family physicians, nurse practitioners, and patients through shared decision-making to assess whether **medications** (prescription, non-prescription, and supplements) are **necessary**, **effective**, **safe**, **and feasible**. They also evaluate the combined safety of all drugs to **manage interactions**, **minimize adverse effects**, **and support adherence**. Recommendations are incorporated into the patient's care plan developed by the primary care provider, with follow-up provided as needed.

How does the PCN Clinical Pharmacist support within the Primary Care setting?

They support the healthcare team through:

- Recommending evidence-based treatments & collaborating with the care team on medication planning & monitoring
- Care Conferencing via the IPT referral form or directly through clinic co-location
- Summarizing patient histories and prior medication use to support shared decisionmaking
- Leading quality improvement initiatives to support chronic disease management, optimizing prescribing patterns, or conducting preventative health care

They support patients through:

- Dedicating time to provide patient education and address their needs/goals relating to medications
- Support medication changes, including deprescribing as appropriate

Patients can be referred for:

- Comprehensive medication review that will incorporate patient-centered goals
- · Polypharmacy and deprescribing
- Assessment of drug-related causes of adverse effects or reactions
- Chronic diseases management; suboptimal drug therapy outcomes
- Starting or stopping medications; switching or cross-tapering between medications
- Medication reconciliation after a recent hospital discharge
