It has been wonderful to have Mildred co-located at our clinic once a month and be a part of our **multidisciplinary team**. I had previously worked in acute care and have been used to working collaboratively with a multidisciplinary team and was happy to hear that this was still possible working in PCN. Mildred has been a **wonderful support** to have to work collaboratively with to review my **complex geriatric patients** with **polypharmacy**, helping with **deprescribing** and **medication reconciliation upon discharge from hospital**.

She has also been a wonderful support in helping with **cross tapering for antidepressants**, reviewing options as some of my patients have tried multiple antidepressants in the past with no benefit, helping with **costs of medications** ie. Cheaper options or if pt is registered with Fair Pharmacare.

She has also helped with **education** and **counselling** around medication- ie. Statins, biphosphonates as pt often worry about side effects and even though I spend the time to review it with them, it is an added benefit for pts have a second review to make an **informed decision**. She has also been a wonderful support in providing education on injectables, proper use of inhalers.
